The Holy Cross men's basketball team returns to action on Wednesday, Jan. 11, when it plays host to Lafayette at 7:05 p.m. The contest between the Crusaders and the Leopards will be televised live by the American Sports Network, and can be seen in New England on NESNplus. The game will also be shown on the internet through the Patriot League Network, and will air live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross has won four of its last six games, but is coming off a 68-49 setback against Bucknell on Sunday. The Crusaders lead the Patriot League in scoring defense (63.3 points per game), steals (8.7 steals per game), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.30-to-1) and turnover margin (+4.8 turnovers per game).

Senior forward **Malachi Alexander** leads the team by averaging 13.9 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.6 steals per game. Senior guard **Robert Champion** has also been playing well, averaging 13.3 points, 3.6 boards and 1.7 steals per contest. In addition, sophomore forward **Karl Charles** has added 9.2 points, 3.9 assists and 3.7 rebounds per game.

Lafayette enters the game with an overall record of 6-9 and a 2-2 mark in the Patriot League. The Leopards have won two of their last three games, but are coming off a 91-75 loss against Boston University on Sunday.

Junior forward Matt Klinewski leads the team by averaging 17.9 points and 6.1 rebounds per game so far this season, while hitting 55.8 percent of his field goal attempts. Senior guard Nick Lindner is also enjoying a strong year, with averages of 13.8 points, 4.8 assists and 3.1 boards per contest.

Following the contest with Lafayette, Holy Cross will hit the road for a game at Lehigh on Saturday, Jan. 14, at 2:00 p.m.

THE SERIES WITH LAFAYETTE: This will be the 63rd meeting between the Crusaders and the Leopards on the hardwood, with Holy Cross leading the all-time series 36-26. The Leopards have been victorious in seven out of the last 10 games between the schools, but the Crusaders won the last meeting 67-53 on Feb. 10, 2016. Holy Cross holds a 21-9 advantage for games played in Worcester, but Lafayette has won five of its last seven trips to the Hart Center. The schools first met on Feb. 4, 1947, with Holy Cross posting a 50-40 victory at the Boston Garden.

BENZAN PLAYS KEY MINUTES IN BACKCOURT: Sophomore guard **Patrick Benzan** has been one of the top players in the Holy Cross backcourt so far this season. In 17 games played, he has averaged 6.6 points, 2.4 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.2 steals per game, while hitting 51.7 percent of his field goal attempts. In the Bucknell game, Benzan tied his career-high with 15 points on six of seven shooting from the field. Previously against Navy, he totaled 12 points, three rebounds and three assists, while hitting the game-winning shot with 0.1 seconds remaining. A few of Benzan's other top games this season have come against Harvard (15 points, three assists) and UMass (12 points, career-best 10 rebounds, four steals). Over the course of his collegiate career, Benzan has now totaled 136 points, 63 rebounds, 50 assists and 26 steals.

ALEXANDER PLAYS PROMINENT ROLE: Senior forward **Malachi Alexander** is once again one of the top players for the Crusaders this year. Through 17 games played, Alexander has averaged 13.9 points, 5.5 rebounds, 1.9 assists and 1.6 steals per contest, while hitting 38.3 percent of his three-point attempts. During the victory at Colgate, he led the team with 18 points and eight rebounds. Previously against Navy, Alexander totaled 17 points, seven rebounds and two steals. He also had a huge game at Sacred Heart, posting a double-double with a career-high 38 points and 10 rebounds, while hitting seven of eight shots from three-point range. A few of Alexander's other top performances this year have come against Albany (17 points, seven rebounds, three assists), Maine (16 points, six rebounds, three steals), South Carolina (15 points, six rebounds, two assists), Rhode Island (15 points, two rebounds, two steals), Massachusetts (14 points, three assists), Monmouth (13 points, five rebounds, five assists), Marist (12 points, four rebounds, four assists, four steals), South Carolina State (11 points, six rebounds) and New Hampshire (10 points, seven rebounds). Last season, he averaged 11.8 points, 5.6 rebounds and 2.8 assists per contest, while hitting 47.1 percent of his field goal attempts and 43.9 percent of his three-pointers. Alexander was named the Most Valuable Player of the 2016 Patriot League Tournament, after averaging 20.8 points and 7.5 rebounds in four games. Over the course of his collegiate career, Alexander has now totaled 1,112 points, 582 rebounds, 194 assists and 98 steals.

CARMODY JOINS 300 WIN CLUB: Bill Carmody is in his second season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2016-2017, with an overall record of 22-29. He owns a career record of 306-274, after earning his 300th career victory with a 63-52 win at Harvard on Nov. 22, 2016. Last season, Carmody led the Crusaders to their first Patriot League Tournament title since 2007 and their first NCAA Tournament victory since 1953. The 17th head coach in the history of the program, he has 33 years of Division I coaching experience, including 18 seasons as a head coach (with 13 years at Northwestern and four seasons at Princeton). Carmody has led his teams to nine postseason tournament appearances — three trips to the NCAA Tournament and six trips to the National Invitation Tournament.

BUCKNELL RECAP

Patrick Benzan tied his career high by scoring 15 points, but Holy Cross was defeated by Bucknell 68-49 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Jan. 8, 2017. The Crusaders made just 37.5 percent of their shots from the floor, while the Bison knocked down 52.9 percent of their field goal attempts. Bucknell also held a 41-21 rebounding advantage. Karl Charles finished the day with 10 points, three rebounds, two assists and two steals. Nana Foulland led the Bison with 17 points and eight rebounds. The game was close early on, with Bucknell holding a 14-10 advantage after the first nine minutes of play. The Bison then went on an 11-3 run over the next four minutes to extend their lead to 12 points (25-13). Holy Cross was able to close to within five points (27-22) late in the half, before Bucknell took a 34-26 advantage into the locker room. The Bucknell lead stayed between seven and 12 points early in the second half, and stood at 42-33 with 12:43 left to play. Bucknell then used an 11-2 spurt to go in front by 18 (53-35) and put the game away. The Bison would lead by as many as 21 points in the closing minutes, before finally posting a 19-point victory.

CHARLES BUILDS ON ALL-ROOKIE SEASON: Sophomore forward **Karl Charles** has been a key player for the Crusaders this season, after being named to the Patriot League All-Rookie and All-Tournament teams a year ago. Through 17 games played this year, he has averaged 9.2 points, 3.9 assists, 3.7 rebounds and 1.5 steals, while hitting 75.8 percent of his free throws. During the Bucknell game, Charles recorded 10 points, three rebounds, two assists and two steals. Previously at Colgate, he totaled 13 points, six assists, three rebounds and two steals. Charles also played well against Marist, posting 10 points, six rebounds, five assists and two steals. A few of his other top games this year have come against New Hampshire (16 points, three rebounds, three assists), South Carolina State (14 points, career-high nine assists, five boards), Quinnipiac (14 points, eight assists, four rebounds, three steals), Harvard (14 points, four rebounds), Monmouth (12 points, eight assists, seven rebounds) and Rhode Island (12 points, four rebounds, three steals). Last season, Charles averaged 10.6 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 1.1 steals and 0.5 blocks per game, while hitting 79.2 percent of his free throws. Over the course of his collegiate career, Charles has totaled 528 points, 209 rebounds, 152 assists, 63 steals and 23 blocked shots.

CHAMPION ENJOYING ANOTHER STRONG SEASON: Senior guard **Robert Champion** is once again a key player in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. Through 17 games played, he has averaged 13.3 points, 3.6 rebounds and 1.7 steals per contest. During the victory at Colgate, Champion posted 12 points and five rebounds. Previously against Navy, he recorded 11 points, four rebounds, two assists, two blocks and two steals. Champion also played well at Boston University, leading the team with 18 points, five rebounds and three steals. A few of his other top games this season have come against Quinnipiac (career-high 28 points, five steals), Marist (23 points, five rebounds, three steals), Albany (22 points, three steals), South Carolina (18 points, four rebounds), South Carolina State (18 points, three rebounds, three assists), Maine (13 points, eight rebounds, two steals) and Sacred Heart (10 points, three steals, two rebounds). Last season, Champion averaged a team-best 12.0 points, 4.8 rebounds and 1.5 assists per contest. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Champion has now totaled 852 points, 305 rebounds, 91 assists and 87 steals.

Malachi Alexander posted team-highs of 14 points and nine rebounds, as the Crusaders defeated Lafayette 67-53 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex on Feb. 10, 2016. After the Leopards opened the game with an early 5-2 advantage, Holy Cross scored seven unanswered points to take a 9-5 lead. The Crusaders were later up 12-11, before using an 8-2 run to pull in front by seven (20-13) with nine minutes left in the half. Alexander and Cullen Hamilton both his three-pointers during that spurt, while Jehyve Floyd added a fast break layup. Lafayette closed back to within two (22-20), before Holy Cross scored the next eight points to increase its lead to 10 (30-20) with two minutes left before the break. The Leopards then closed out the half with a 7-1 run to trail by just four points (31-27) heading into the locker room. The Crusaders came out firing on all cylinders in the second half, using a quick 6-2 spurt to build their lead back up to eight points. Holy Cross was later up by six (44-38) with 11:23 left to play, when Alexander knocked down back-to-back three-pointers make it a 12-point game (50-38). A few minutes later, the Crusaders used a 9-3 run to pull in front by 15 (61-46) and put the game away. Robert Champion scored five of Holy Cross' points during that spurt, while Anthony Thompson netted the other four points. The Leopards would get no closer than 10 points the rest of the way, as the Crusaders eventually posted a 14-point victory. Champion (12 points, nine rebounds), Thompson (12 points, three rebounds), Karl Charles (10 points, six rebounds) and Hamilton (10 points, four assists) all joined Alexander in double figures. Bryce Scott led Lafayette with 18 points and three rebounds. Holy Cross hit 42.1 percent of its shots on the night (24 of 57), in addition to holding a 40-21 rebounding advantage.

HOLY CROSS STEPS UP ON DEFENSE: The Crusaders have been one of the top defensive teams in the Patriot League during the 2016-2017 season. In 17 games played, Holy Cross limited its opponents to just 63.3 points per game. The Crusaders have forced 15.4 turnovers per contest this year, while averaging 8.7 steals per game. Holy Cross has held eight of its 17 opponents to under 60 points, with lows of 49 points by Albany and 50 points by Navy.

THOMPSON RETURNS TO BACKCOURT: Senior guard **Anthony Thompson** is once again a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt this year. Through 17 games played, Thompson has averaged 6.5 points, 2.4 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.5 steals per contest. In the victory at Colgate, he totaled 12 points, four assists and two rebounds. Previously against Monmouth, Thompson scored a team-high 18 points while hitting four of five three-point attempts. A few of his other top games this year have come against Massachusetts (14 points) and Syracuse (12 points). Last season, Thompson averaged 7.1 points, 2.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.1 steals per contest, while hitting 79.5 percent of his free throws. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Thompson has now totaled 777 points, 247 assists, 241 rebounds and 118 steals, while making 73.7 percent of his free throws (230 of 312).

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: This year marks the 97th season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1,383-961 (.590), while making 26 postseason tournament appearances — 13 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 10 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally and had 15 players who have coached in college.

PROTECTING THE BALL: In 17 games played so far this season, the Crusaders have only turned the ball over 180 times, for an average of 10.6 turnovers per contest. Holy Cross has posted single-digit turnovers six times this year, including a season-low of seven at both Boston University and Harvard. Last year, the Crusaders committed only 386 turnovers in 35 games, for a Patriot League-low average of 11.0 turnovers per contest. In 2014-2015, Holy Cross averaged 10.9 turnovers per contest, with 328 total turnovers in 30 games. That mark was the lowest in the Patriot League and also set a school single-season record.

HART IS WHERE THE HOME IS: Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 367-154 at the Hart Center at the Luth Athletic Complex, including a 4-1 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-2007 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 35 out of 41 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 155-62 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 99-35 record against Patriot League foes.

STEALING THE SHOW: In 17 games played so far this season, Holy Cross has averaged a Patriot League-best 8.7 steals per contest. The Crusaders have reached double figures in steals eight times this year, with a high of 16 steals against Quinnipiac. The 16 steals against the Bobcats were the most by Holy Cross in a single game since Nov. 12, 2006, when it had 16 steals against Fairfield. Senior guard **Robert Champion** leads the team with 29 steals, followed by senior forward **Malachi Alexander** (27 steals), sophomore forward **Karl Charles** (26 steals) and senior guard **Anthony Thompson** (25 steals).

CRUSADERS LOOKING FOR SIXTH PATRIOT LEAGUE REGULAR SEASON TITLE: During the 2016-2017 campaign, Holy Cross will attempt to win the Patriot League regular season title for the sixth time in school history. The last championship for the Crusaders came in 2006-2007, when they tied for first place in the conference with Bucknell, as both teams posted 13-1 records in league play. Prior to that, Holy Cross won outright Patriot League regular season titles in 2001, 2003 and 2005, while sharing the regular season championship in 1994. The Crusaders' five total championships are tied for the second-most in conference history with Navy (one outright, four shared), behind only Bucknell (seven outright, three shared).

HUSEK STEPS UP IN THE POST: Senior center **Matt Husek** has been one of Holy Cross' top players down low this season. In 17 games played, he has averaged 6.8 points and 2.4 rebounds, while hitting 47.7 percent of his field goal attempts. In the Boston University game, Husek totaled 14 points, four rebounds and two assists. Previously against Marist, he finished with 12 points and two blocked shots. Husek also played well against Quinnipiac, posting 10 points and four assists. A few of his other top games this year have come against Monmouth (12 points, four rebounds, two assists, two steals) and South Carolina State (12 points, five rebounds). Last season, Husek averaged 5.7 points, 2.9 rebounds and 0.8 blocks per contest. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has now totaled 377 points, 167 rebounds and 54 blocked shots.

ALEXANDER TIES THREE-POINT RECORD AT SACRED HEART: During the Dec. 21 game at Sacred Heart, senior forward **Malachi Alexander** tied the all-time Holy Cross single-game record for three-point field goals made. Alexander drained seven of eight attempts from behind the arc against the Pioneers, becoming the sixth player in school history to hit seven three-pointers in a game. The feat was previously accomplished by Rob Feaster (at New Hampshire, Nov. 25, 1994), Kevin Hamilton (vs. Chattanooga, Dec. 19, 2005), Devin Brown (vs. Navy, Feb. 16, 2011), Cullen Hamilton (vs. Sacred Heart, Nov. 13, 2013) and senior guard **Robert Champion** (at Lehigh, Feb. 15, 2016).

CRUSADERS PICKED FOURTH IN PRESEASON POLL: In the 2016-2017 Patriot League preseason poll, Holy Cross was picked to finish in fourth place in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors. The Crusaders received 115 total points in the conference preseason poll. Lehigh placed first in the poll, with 161 total points and 17 first-place votes, followed by Boston University in second with 139 points and three first-place votes, and Bucknell in third with 132 points. American placed fifth with 86 points, while Colgate was sixth (83 points) and Loyola (Md.) was seventh (69 points). The preseason rankings were rounded out by Navy (eight, 49 points), Lafayette (ninth, 43 points) and Army West Point (10th, 23 points).

THE 1,000-POINT CLUB: During the game at Rhode Island on Dec. 18, senior forward **Malachi Alexander** became the 50th 1,000-point scorer in the history of Holy Cross men's basketball. He scored his 1,000th career point by knocking down the front end of a one-and-one with 5:19 remaining in the first half. Alexander has scored 1,112 points in 116 career games as a Crusader, good for an average of 9.6 points per contest. Senior guard **Robert Champion** currently has 852 career points scored, and could also join the 1,000-point club this season.

Sophomore forward **Jehyve Floyd** scored a season-high eight points at Rhode Island, then grabbed a career-best seven rebounds at Sacred Heart. He is now averaging 2.1 points, 1.5 rebounds and 0.6 blocks per game this season, while hitting 51.9 percent of his field goal attempts ...
