The Holy Cross men's basketball team hits the road this week, when it travels to American for a 7:30 p.m. contest on Monday, Feb. 1. The game between the Crusaders and the Eagles can be seen live on the internet through the Patriot League Network. In addition, the contest will air live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross enters the game with an overall record of 9-12 and a 4-6 mark in the Patriot League. The Crusaders defeated Navy 87-80 in overtime on Saturday afternoon, to snap a two-game losing streak. Holy Cross is currently in seventh place in the Patriot League, but is only a game and a half out of fourth place.

Junior guard **Robert Champion** leads the team by averaging 12.0 points, 4.4 rebounds and 1.1 steals per game. Junior forward **Malachi Alexander** has also been playing well, with averages of 11.4 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2.9 assists per contest. Freshman forward **Karl Charles** has added 10.8 points, 4.4 rebounds and 1.1 steals per game, while senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** is chipping in with 9.6 points and 2.6 boards per contest.

American stands 5-15 overall this season with a 3-6 mark against Patriot League opponents. After losing 10 straight games from Dec. 6-Jan. 17, the Eagles have now won three straight. American is coming off a 54-49 victory at Colgate on Saturday afternoon, but stands 0-6 at home this year.

Senior guard Jesse Reed leads the team by averaging 12.5 points and 4.0 rebounds per game, while hitting 47.1 percent of his field goal attempts (89 of 189). Freshman guard Delante Jones has added 10.7 points and 3.4 boards per contest, while junior center Paris Maragkos is averaging 8.3 points and 2.8 rebounds per game.

After the contest with American, the Crusaders will return home to face Bucknell at 1:05 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 6.

THE SERIES WITH AMERICAN: This will be the 36th meeting between the Crusaders and the Eagles on the hardwood, with Holy Cross leading the all-time series 18-17. American has won six straight and 12 of the last 15 contests played by the schools. For games played in Washington the Eagles hold a 12-7 advantage with 10 straight wins. Holy Cross and American first played on Dec. 21, 1967, with the Crusaders winning 81-57 on the road.

ALEXANDER PLAYING PROMINENT ROLE: Junior forward **Malachi Alexander** is one of the top players for the Crusaders down low this year. Through 21 games played, Alexander has averaged 11.4 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2.9 assists per contest, while making 49.4 percent of his field goal attempts (80 of 162). During the victory over Navy, he led the team with a career-high 26 points, eight rebounds, three assists and two blocked shots, while hitting 12 of 13 free throws. Previously against Loyola (Md.), Alexander recorded 11 points, four rebounds and three steals. He also played well against Army, tallying 20 points, six rebounds and three steals. Some of Alexander's other top performances this season have come against Albany (18 points, six rebounds, four assists), against Harvard (17 points, five rebounds), against Boston University (17 points), against New Hampshire (13 points, six rebounds, seven assists), at Hartford (11 points, nine rebounds, six assists, three steals), against Sacred Heart (11 points, five rebounds, three assists), at Kansas (11 points, two rebounds, two steals), at Navy (10 points, four rebounds) and against Lehigh (10 points, four assists, three rebounds). In 30 games played last year, Alexander averaged 8.4 points and 5.0 rebounds, while hitting 73.5 percent of his free throws (72 of 98). As a freshman in 2013-2014, he averaged 6.3 points and 4.2 rebounds per game. Over the course of his collegiate career, Alexander has now totaled 704 points, 403 rebounds and 123 assists.

HAMILTON STILL A TOP SCORING THREAT: Senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** is once again a key player for the Crusaders on the wing this season. In 21 games played this year, Hamilton has averaged 9.6 points and 2.6 rebounds per contest, while hitting 81.4 percent (35 of 43) of his free throws. In the victory over Navy, he scored a season-high 24 points on nine of 13 shooting from the field. Previously at Lafayette, Hamilton recorded 10 points and five rebounds. He also played well against Colgate, tallying 20 points, four rebounds and four assists, while hitting seven of nine field goal attempts. A few of Hamilton's other top games this season have come at Brown (18 points), against Maine (13 points, four assists, career-best three steals), at Hartford (12 points, three assists, two rebounds), against Boston University (11 points, three rebounds, two assists), against Albany (11 points, three rebounds, two steals), at Marist (11 points, two rebounds) and against Sacred Heart (10 points). In 30 games played last season, he averaged 6.6 points and 2.4 rebounds. During the 2013-2014 campaign, Hamilton averaged 8.2 points and 1.8 rebounds per contest, but missed 15 games due to injury. A Patriot League All-Rookie selection in 2012-2013, he has now totaled 742 points, 249 rebounds and 107 assists over the course of his collegiate career, while making 77.6 percent of his free throws (111 of 143).

CRUSADERS HAVE TWO 20-POINT SCORERS: During Saturday's win over Navy, two Holy Cross players scored at least 20 points. Junior forward **Malachi Alexander** led the way with 26 points, while senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** finished with 24 points. That marked the third time this season that two Crusaders have hit the 20-point mark in the same game. During the Army game on Jan. 20, both Alexander and freshman forward **Karl Charles** scored 20 points, while in the Jan. 6 contest against Colgate, Charles scored 21 points and Hamilton added 20 points. Holy Cross has now won six straight games when it has multiple 20-point scorers, dating back to the 2011-2012 season.

NAVY RECAP

Malachi Alexander totaled a career-high 26 points, eight rebounds, three assists and two blocked shots, to lead Holy Cross to an 87-80 overtime victory over Navy at the Hart Center on Jan. 30, 2016. Cullen Hamilton also had an outstanding game, recording a season-high 24 points on nine of 13 shooting from the field. Robert Champion added 14 points on six of 10 shooting for the Crusaders. Holy Cross hit 77.1 percent of its free throws on the afternoon (27 of 35), led by Alexander with a 12 of 13 performance. Navy was led by Shawn Anderson with 25 points and eight rebounds, while Tilman Dunbar added 24 points and four assists. The Midshipmen led by six points (63-57) with 2:57 remaining in the second half, when Champion converted a three-point play to cut the margin to three points. Navy was back up by five with 1:33 left, before Alexander drilled a three-pointer to make the score 67-65. A pair of free throws by junior guard Anthony Thompson with 13.3 seconds on the clock would later tie the game at 69-69 and force overtime. With 2:33 remaining in the extra session, a three-point play by Alexander made the score 76-73 and gave the Crusaders the lead for good. Holy Cross went on to hit nine of 12 free throws in the final minute of overtime, including seven of eight by Alexander, to pull out the victory. The Midshipmen had led by as many as 12 points in the first half, before taking a 39-34 advantage into the locker room. The Navy lead then stayed between three and eight points for the majority of the second half, before the Crusaders rallied to force overtime.

CHAMPION PLAYS KEY ROLE ON PERIMETER: Junior guard **Robert Champion** is once again a key player in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 21 games played, he has averaged 12.0 points, 4.4 rebounds and 1.1 steals per contest, while hitting 73.8 percent (48 of 65) of his free throws. Champion has played particularly well over the last 12 games, scoring 20 or more points four times in that stretch. During the victory over Navy, he scored 14 points on six of 10 shooting from the field. Previously at Colgate, Champion recorded 12 points, three rebounds and two assists. He also played well at Lafayette, leading the team with a career-high 24 points and six rebounds. Some of Champion's other top games this season have been at Hartford (22 points, four rebounds, three steals), at Navy (20 points, seven rebounds), against Maine (20 points, career-best seven assists), against New Hampshire (19 points, four assists, three steals), at Marist (16 points, career-high eight rebounds), at Rhode Island (13 points, four rebounds), at Brown (12 points, seven rebounds, four steals), against Albany (11 points, six rebounds) and against Boston University (11 points, five assists, three steals, two rebounds). In 29 games played a year ago, he averaged 4.8 points and 1.8 rebounds, while hitting 46.8 percent of his field goal attempts (51 of 109) and 37.9 percent of his three-pointers (22 of 58). Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Champion has now totaled 453 points, 163 rebounds and 45 steals.

CARMODY IN FIRST SEASON WITH THE CRUSADERS: Bill Carmody is in his first season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2015-2016, with an overall record of 9-12. The 17th head coach in the history of the program, Carmody came to the Crusaders with 32 years of Division I coaching experience, including 17 seasons as a head coach. From 2000-2013, Carmody served as the head coach at Northwestern University. In the four years from 2008-2012, he guided the Wildcats to four consecutive winning seasons, with his 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 teams both recording a school record 20 victories. Carmody, who previously spent four seasons as the head coach at Princeton University from 1996-2000, had led his teams to eight postseason tournament appearances — two trips to the NCAA Tournament and six trips to the National Invitation Tournament. He was selected as the Big Ten Conference Coach of the Year in 2003-2004, and owns a career record of 293-257.

Malcolm Miller scored a game-high 19 points, but the Crusaders were defeated by American 57-50 at the Hart Center on Feb. 2, 2015. Miller hit seven of 13 field goal attempts on the night, while also recording eight rebounds, two assists and two blocked shots. Holy Cross made 51.3 percent of its field goal attempts in the game (20 of 39), but was only able to connect on 58.3 percent of its free throws (seven of 12). American hit 46.5 percent of its shots from the floor (20 of 43), 58.8 percent of its three-pointers (10 of 17) and 77.8 percent of its foul shots (seven of nine) on the night. Both teams struggled to score early on, and the score was tied at 6-6 after the first seven minutes of play. The Crusaders then went on a 13-2 run in a span of 5:18 to take a commanding 19-8 lead. Holy Cross was still up by eight points (23-15) late in

the half, before Pee Wee Gardner hit a three-pointer at the halftime buzzer to make the score 23-18 heading into the locker room. The Crusaders opened the second half with a quick 7-2 spurt to build their lead back up to double figures (30-20) with 16:51 left to play. But the Eagles responded with a 12-4 run of their own, including four three-pointers, to make it a two-point game (34-32) with 12:02 remaining. Holy Cross held onto a small lead for the next several minutes, before a layup by Gardner with 6:39 left put American up 44-43. The Crusaders regained the lead (45-44) on a layup by Miller, before the Eagles used a 6-0 spurt to pull in front for good. Holy Cross was able to get within two points (50-48) with under a minute remaining, but American hit five of six free throws in the final 30 seconds to hold on for the win. Gardner and Jesse Reed led the Eagles with 12 points each.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: This year marks the 97th season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1369-944 (.592), while making 25 postseason tournament appearances — 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 10 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally, and had 15 players who have coached in college.

CHARLES STEPS INTO STARTING LINEUP: Freshman forward **Karl Charles** has made an immediate impact for the Crusaders this season. In 21 games played, Charles has averaged 10.8 points, 4.4 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.1 steals per contest, while hitting 81.2 percent of his free throws (82 of 101). He has stepped up his play even more since the start of Patriot League action, averaging 12.3 points and 5.8 rebounds against conference foes, and hitting 86.2 percent of his foul shots (50 of 58). During the Loyola (Md.) game, Charles led the team with 17 points and eight rebounds. Previously against Army, he posted his first career double-double with 20 points and 15 rebounds. Charles also played well in the first meeting with Colgate, leading the team with a career-high 21 points, eight rebounds, five assists, four blocked shots and three steals. A few of his other top games have come at Navy (16 points, five rebounds, three steals), against Sacred Heart (15 points, seven rebounds), against Boston University (15 points, six rebounds, five assists), at Hartford (13 points, three assists, two steals), against Maine (13 points) and at Kansas (12 points, four steals, three rebounds, two assists). Charles came to Holy Cross from Rutgers Preparatory School in Somerset, N.J., where he averaged 15.6 points, 8.2 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.6 steals per game as a senior.

PROTECTING THE BALL: The Crusaders have committed only 251 turnovers in 21 games played this year, for a Patriot League-low average of 12.0 turnovers per contest. Holy Cross has had single-digit turnovers seven times this year, including a season-low six against both Lehigh and Quinnipiac. Last year, Holy Cross averaged 10.9 turnovers per contest, with 328 total turnovers in 30 games. That mark was the lowest in the Patriot League, and also set a new school single-season record. The Crusaders broke the record that had been set just one year earlier at 11.7 turnovers per contest in 2013-2014 (398 in 34 games).

CRUSADERS PICKED EIGHTH IN PRESEASON POLL: In the 2015-2016 Patriot League preseason poll, Holy Cross was picked to finish in eighth place in voting by the conference's head coaches and sports information directors. The Crusaders received 50 total points in the conference preseason poll. Lehigh placed first in the poll, with 156 total points and 12 first-place votes, followed by Bucknell in second with 150 points and eight first-place votes, and Boston University in third with 126 points. Army West Point placed fourth with 108 points, while American was fifth (84 points), Lafayette was sixth (82 points) and Loyola (Md.) was seventh (73 points). The preseason rankings were rounded out by Colgate (ninth, 36 points) and Navy (10th, 35 points).

HOLY CROSS LOOKING FOR SIXTH PATRIOT LEAGUE REGULAR SEASON TITLE: During the 2015-2016 campaign, Holy Cross will attempt to win the Patriot League regular season title for the sixth time in school history. The last championship for the Crusaders came in 2006-2007, when they tied for first place in the conference with Bucknell, as both teams posted 13-1 records in league play. Prior to that, Holy Cross won outright Patriot League regular season titles in 2001, 2003 and 2005, while sharing the regular season championship in 1994. The Crusaders' five total championships are tied for the second-most in conference history with Navy (one outright, four shared), behind only Bucknell (six outright, three shared).

HUSEK STEPS UP IN THE POST: Junior center **Matt Husek** has developed into one of Holy Cross' top players down low this season. In 21 games played, Husek has averaged 7.5 points, 3.9 rebounds and 1.2 blocked shots per contest, while hitting 47.3 percent of his field goal attempts (61 of 129) and 42.5 percent of his three-pointers (17 of 40). During the Lehigh game, he led the team with a career-high 23 points on eight of 11 shooting from the field. Previously against Maine, Husek posted his second double-double of the year with 19 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. He also played well at Hartford, totaling 11 points and eight rebounds. A few of Husek's other top performances this season came against Quinnipiac (15 points, five rebounds, two assists, two blocks) and Marist (12 points, 12 rebounds). Last season, Husek averaged 3.0 points and 0.9 rebounds in 22 games played. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has now totaled 223 points, 108 rebounds and 40 blocked shots.

HOLY CROSS IN THE NCAA STATISTICS: The Crusaders are currently ranked among the NCAA Division I leaders in six statistical categories, through games of Jan. 30. In addition, three Holy Cross players stand among the best in the nation in various individual categories. The rankings:

CRUSADERS KNOCK DOWN FREE THROWS: Holy Cross is once again a strong free throw shooting team in 2015-2016. Through 21 games played, the Crusaders have made 72.0 percent of their foul shots (309 of 429). Senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** leads the team by making 81.4 percent of his attempts at this charity stripe this season (35 of 43). Freshman forward **Karl Charles** (81.2 percent, 82 of 101), junior guard **Anthony Thompson** (75.9 percent, 41 of 54) and junior guard **Robert Champion** (73.8 percent, 48 of 65) have also connected on over 73 percent of their foul shots this year. As a team, the Crusaders have hit over 70 percent of their free throws in each of the last four seasons. Holy Cross made 71.5 percent of its foul shots in 2014-2015 (406 of 568), 73.2 percent in 2013-2014 (518 of 708), 75.3 percent in 2012-2013 (351 of 466) and 72.1 percent in 2011-2012 (374 of 519).

THOMPSON RETURNS TO BACKCOURT: Junior guard **Anthony Thompson** is once again a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 21 games played, Thompson has averaged 6.9 points, 3.0 assists, 2.4 rebounds and 1.0 steals per contest, while hitting 75.9 percent of his free throws (41 of 54). During the game at Colgate, he led the team with 14 points, three assists, two rebounds and two steals. Previously at Bucknell, Thompson recorded 16 points, three rebounds, three assists and two steals. He also played well against Albany, totaling a career-high 23 points, four rebounds and three assists, while hitting six of 10 attempts from three-point range. A few of Thompson's other top games this season have come against Harvard (13 points, seven of seven free throws), against Sacred Heart (10 points, three assists, two rebounds, two steals) and against New Hampshire (11 points, five assists, four steals). In 20 games played last season, he averaged 5.9 points, 2.2 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.3 steals. In 2013-2014, Thompson was named to the Patriot League All-Rookie team after averaging 9.4 points, 2.5 assists, 2.2 rebounds and 0.9 steals per game. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, he has now totaled 563 points, 183 assists, 163 rebounds and 78 steals, while making 74.0 percent of his free throws (182 of 246).

CRUSADERS AT THE HART CENTER: Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 362-150 at the Hart Center, including a 7-4 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-2007 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 34 out of 40 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 150-58 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 97-32 record against Patriot League foes.

ZIGNORSKI PLAYS KEY ROLE OFF THE BENCH: Freshman guard **Matt Zignorski** has become a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt rotation this year. In 19 games played, Zignorski has averaged 4.6 points per game while hitting 38.6 percent (17 of 44) of his three-point field goals. During the Rhode Island game, he scored 10 points and grabbed two rebounds. Previously against Sacred Heart, Zignorski totaled 13 points and two rebounds. He also played well at Quinnipiac, finishing with 10 points and two assists. Zignorski came to Holy Cross from Pope John XXIII Regional High School in Sparta, N.J., where he led the team to an overall record of 29-4 and the New Jersey Non-Public A state championship as a senior.

FOUR CRUSADERS NAMED TO PATRIOT LEAGUE 25TH ANNIVERSARY TEAM: Four former Holy Cross men's basketball players were selected to the Patriot League 25th Anniversary Team, comprised of the top 25 players in the history of the conference. **Rob Feaster** (1991-1995), **Kevin Hamilton** (2002-2006), **Keith Simmons** (2003-2007) and **Tim Szatko** (1999-2003) were all recognized for their outstanding accomplishments during their careers with the Crusaders. Holy Cross' four selections were the second-most in the league, behind only Bucknell with six.

HOLY CROSS TIES THREE-POINT SHOOTING MARK: In the Nov. 19 game against New Hampshire, the Crusaders tied the school single-game records for both three-point field goals made (15) and three-point field goals attempted (35), in addition to tying the Hart Center record with 15 three-pointers made. Holy Cross previously made 15 three-pointers at Army on Jan. 11, 2006, while attempting 35 three-pointers at Lehigh on Jan. 17, 2015. The only other time a team made 15 three-pointers at the Hart Center came on Dec. 5, 1988, when Assumption accomplished the feat against Holy Cross.

CHECK YOUR CALENDAR: Due to the blizzard on the East coast last weekend, two changes were made to Holy Cross' schedule. The game at American, originally scheduled for Jan. 24, has been moved to Monday, Feb. 1, at 7:30 p.m. In addition, the contest at Colgate, which was to be played on Feb. 3, took place on Jan 24.

DRIBBLES: Senior guard **Eric Green** posted six points, five rebounds and two steals in the Jan. 30 win over Navy, in only his fifth game back after missing the majority of the season due to injury ... During the Jan. 27 game against Loyola (Md.), members of the Holy Cross coaching staff took part in Coaches vs. Cancer Suits & Sneakers Awareness Week ... Freshman forward **Jehyve Floyd** recorded career-highs of seven points and three blocked shots in the Jan. 20 victory over Army ... Freshman guard **Pat Benzan** posted career-highs of six assists and four rebounds against Lehigh on Jan. 16 ... During the Jan. 13 game at Lafayette, the Crusaders did not allow the Leopards to grab any offensive rebounds ... Junior guard **Robert Champion** scored at least 20 points three times in a four-game stretch from Dec. 12-Jan. 2. Prior to Champion, the last Crusader with three 20-point performances in a four-game stretch was Devin Brown, who accomplished the feat in three straight games from Jan. 3-11, 2012 ... The Crusaders stand 16-10 all-time in their first Patriot League game of the season, following this year's 80-64 victory over Boston University. Holy Cross has now won its opening Patriot League game 11 times in the last 17 years ... Holy Cross made a season-high 66.0 percent of its field goal attempts (33 of 50) in the 90-68 victory at Hartford on Dec. 12 ... The 50-49 victory over Harvard marked the first time the Crusaders won a game when scoring 50 points or less since Nov. 9, 2012 (a 46-45 win at Old Dominion) ... With the 67-64 victory at Marist, Holy Cross improved to 68-29 all-time in season openers. The Crusaders have now won two straight openers and three of their last four ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2005 through 2008, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 98 percent, tied for the third-best mark among all Division I schools ... Holy Cross has received an NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award in each of the last 10 seasons, for having a multi-year APR in the top 10 percent of all Division I men's basketball teams in the nation.
