The Holy Cross men's basketball team returns home this weekend, when it plays host to American in a 12:05 p.m. contest at the Hart Center on Sunday, Feb. 21. Prior to tip-off, members of the Crusaders' senior class will be honored in a special pregame ceremony. The contest between Holy Cross and American can be seen live on the internet through Crusader Vision and the Patriot League Network. In addition, the contest will air live on WEEI 1440 AM in Worcester.

Holy Cross enters the game with an overall record of 10-16 and a 5-10 mark in the Patriot League. The Crusaders have lost four of their last five games, and are coming off a 72-68 setback at Army on Wednesday night. Holy Cross, which currently stands in ninth place in the Patriot League, owns an 8-5 record at the Hart Center so far this season.

Junior guard **Robert Champion** leads the team by averaging 11.8 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.2 steals per game. Junior forward **Malachi Alexander** has also been playing well, with averages of 10.9 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.8 assists per contest. Freshman forward **Karl Charles** has added 10.3 points, 4.2 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game, while senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** is chipping in with 9.7 points and 2.7 boards per contest.

American stands 8-18 overall this season with a 6-9 mark against Patriot League opponents. The Eagles are coming off a 60-59 overtime victory over Lafayette on Wednesday night, which snapped a three-game losing streak.

Senior guard Jesse Reed leads the team by averaging 12.2 points and 4.1 rebounds per game, while hitting 45.4 percent of his field goal attempts (113 of 249). Freshman guard Delante Jones has added 11.5 points and 3.8 boards per contest, while junior center Paris Maragkos is averaging 7.7 points and 2.5 rebounds per game.

After the contest with American, the Crusaders will hit the road once again, for a 7:30 p.m. game at Loyola (Md.) on Wednesday, Feb. 24.

THE SERIES WITH AMERICAN: This will be the 37th meeting between the Crusaders and the Eagles on the hardwood, with the all-time series tied at 18-18. American has won seven straight and 13 of the last 16 contests played by the schools. The Crusaders hold a 11-5 advantage for games played in Worcester, but the Eagles have won their last two visits to the Hart Center. Holy Cross and American first played on Dec. 21, 1967, with the Crusaders winning 81-57 on the road.

HAMILTON STILL A TOP SCORING THREAT: Senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** is once again a key player for the Crusaders on the wing this season. In 26 games played this year, Hamilton has averaged 9.7 points and 2.7 rebounds per contest, while hitting 80.8 percent (42 of 52) of his free throws. In the Army game, he recorded 17 points, three steals, two rebounds and two assists. Previously against Lafayette, Hamilton totaled 10 points, four assists and two steals. He also played well at American, leading the team with 18 points and three rebounds. A few of Hamilton's other top games this season have come against Navy (24 points) against Colgate (20 points, four rebounds, four assists), at Brown (18 points), against Maine (13 points, four assists, three steals), at Hartford (12 points, three assists, two rebounds), against Boston University (11 points, three rebounds, two assists), against Albany (11 points, three rebounds, two steals), at Marist (11 points, two rebounds), at Lafayette (10 points, five rebounds) and against Sacred Heart (10 points). In 30 games played last season, he averaged 6.6 points and 2.4 rebounds. During the 2013-2014 campaign, Hamilton averaged 8.2 points and 1.8 rebounds per contest, but missed 15 games due to injury. A Patriot League All-Rookie selection in 2012-2013, he has now totaled 789 points, 260 rebounds and 119 assists over the course of his collegiate career, while making 77.6 percent of his free throws (118 of 152).

PROTECTING THE BALL: The Crusaders have committed only 303 turnovers in 26 games played this year, for a Patriot League-low average of 11.7 turnovers per contest. Holy Cross has had single-digit turnovers nine times this year, including a season-low of six against both Lehigh and Quinnipiac. Last year, Holy Cross averaged 10.9 turnovers per contest, with 328 total turnovers in 30 games. That mark was the lowest in the Patriot League, and also set a new school single-season record. The Crusaders broke the record that had been set just one year earlier at 11.7 turnovers per contest in 2013-2014 (398 in 34 games).

ALEXANDER PLAYING PROMINENT ROLE: Junior forward **Malachi Alexander** is one of the top players for the Crusaders down low this year. Through 26 games played, Alexander has averaged 10.9 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.8 assists per contest. In the Army game, he recorded 17 points, six rebounds and three assists. Previously against Lafayette, Alexander led the team with 14 points, nine rebounds and three assists. He also played well against Navy, totaling a career-high 26 points, eight rebounds, three assists and two blocked shots, while hitting 12 of 13 free throws. Some of Alexander's other top performances this season have come against Army (20 points, six rebounds, three steals), against Albany (18 points, six rebounds, four assists), against Harvard (17 points, five rebounds), against Boston University (17 points), against New Hampshire (13 points, six rebounds, seven assists), at Hartford (11 points, nine rebounds, six assists, three steals), against Sacred Heart (11 points, five rebounds, three assists), against Loyola (11 points, four rebounds, three steals), at Kansas (11 points, two rebounds, two steals), at Navy (10 points, four rebounds) and against Lehigh (10 points, four assists, three rebounds). In 30 games played last year, Alexander averaged 8.4 points and 5.0 rebounds, while hitting 73.5 percent of his free throws (72 of 98). As a freshman in 2013-2014, he averaged 6.3 points and 4.2 rebounds per game. Over the course of his collegiate career, Alexander has now totaled 747 points, 435 rebounds and 136 assists.

ARMY RECAP

Malachi Alexander totaled 17 points, six rebounds and three assists, but Holy Cross was defeated by Army 72-68 at Christl Arena on Feb. 17, 2016. Cullen Hamilton also played well for the Crusaders, totaling 17 points, three steals, two rebounds and two assists. The Black Knights were led by Kevin Ferguson with 25 points and 13 rebounds. Army made 49.1 percent of its field goal attempts (28 of 57) on the night, while Holy Cross was only able to connect on 42.4 percent of its shots from the floor (25 of 59). The Black Knights also held a 39-28 rebounding advantage. The game was close early on, and Army held a 14-11 lead with 9:15 left in the first half. The Black Knights then used a 9-2 spurt over the next four minutes to extend their advantage to 10 points (23-13). The Crusaders came back a few minutes later with a 6-0 run, but still trailed by five points (34-29) heading into the locker room. Early in the second half, Army used an 11-2 spurt to push its lead back to double figures (45-34). But after the Black Knights led 47-36 with 15:38 remaining, Holy Cross scored nine of the next 11 points to cut the margin down to four (49-45). Army was later up 56-49, before the Crusaders used an 8-0 run to claim a 57-56 lead. Holy Cross was still up by one (59-58) with 4:22 left to play, before the Black Knights used an 8-2 spurt to pull back in front for good. The Crusaders would have one last chance when they trailed 71-68 with less than 15 seconds remaining, but a three-point attempt by Anthony Thompson rimmed out and Army was able to hold on for the win.

SENIOR SALUTE: Five members of the Holy Cross basketball program will be concluding their collegiate careers at the end of the 2015-2016 season. Senior forward **Isaiah Baker**, senior guard **Eric Green**, senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** and senior forward **Christopher Morgan** will be honored prior to the Feb. 21 game against American, along with team manager **Hayward Shine**. The pregame ceremony is scheduled to begin at approximately 11:45 a.m.

CHAMPION PLAYS KEYROLE ON PERIMETER: Junior guard **Robert Champion** is once again a key player in the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 26 games played, Champion has averaged 11.8 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.2 steals per contest, while hitting 73.7 percent (56 of 76) of his free throws. During the Lehigh game, he led the team with a career-high 25 points and seven rebounds, while hitting seven of 11 three-pointers. Previously against Lafayette, Champion totaled 12 points and a career-high nine rebounds. He also played well against Navy, scoring 14 points on six of 10 shooting from the field. Some of Champion's other top games this season have been at Lafayette (career-high 24 points, six rebounds), at Hartford (22 points, four rebounds, three steals), at Navy (20 points, seven rebounds), against Maine (20 points, career-best seven assists), against New Hampshire (19 points, four assists, three steals), at Marist (16 points, career-high eight rebounds), at Rhode Island (13 points, four rebounds), at Brown (12 points, seven rebounds, four steals), at Colgate (12 points, three rebounds), against Albany (11 points, six rebounds) and against Boston University (11 points, five assists, three steals). In 29 games played a year ago, he averaged 4.8 points and 1.8 rebounds, while hitting 46.8 percent of his field goal attempts (51 of 109) and 37.9 percent of his three-pointers (22 of 58). Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Champion has now totaled 511 points, 197 rebounds and 52 steals.

CHAMPION TIES THREE-POINT RECORD AT LEHIGH: During the Feb. 15 game at Lehigh, junior guard **Robert Champion** tied the all-time Holy Cross single-game record for three-point field goals made. Champion drained seven of 11 attempts from behind the arc against the Mountain Hawks, becoming the fifth player in school history to hit seven three-pointers in a game. The feat was previously accomplished by Rob Feaster (at New Hampshire, Nov. 25, 1994), Kevin Hamilton (vs. Chattanooga, Dec. 19, 2005), Devin Brown (vs. Navy, Feb. 16, 2011) and senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** (vs. Sacred Heart, Nov. 13, 2013).

THE LAST MEETING

Cullen Hamilton scored a game-high 18 points, but Holy Cross was defeated by American 58-45 at Bender Arena on Feb. 1, 2016. The Crusaders struggled to shoot the ball for most of the first half, hitting just four of their first 20 shots as American built a 14-8 lead with five minutes left before the break. Holy Cross came back to close out the half on a 7-2 run, and trailed by just one point (16-15) heading into the locker room. After the Crusaders tied the score at 18-18 early in the second half, the Eagles scored 10 straight points to claim a 28-18 advantage with 14:17 left to play. But Holy Cross responded with an 11-0 run of its own, to take a 29-28 lead with 11:27 on the clock. American came back with three-point field goals on each of its next two possessions to pull in front, and would later lead 34-32 with 9:45 remaining. An 8-2 run then allowed the Eagles to extend the margin to eight points (42-34), and Holy Cross would get no closer than seven the rest of the night. American went on to hit nine of 10 free throws in the final two minutes to pull away for a 13-point victory. Robert Champion finished with nine points and four rebounds, while Anthony Thompson added six points, five rebounds, three assists and three steals. The Crusaders made just 36.0 percent of their field goal attempts (18 of 50), 14.3 percent of their three-pointers (two of 14) and 46.7 percent of their free throws (seven of 15) on the night. The Eagles were able to connect on 42.2 percent of their shots from the floor (19 of 45) and 83.3 percent from the charity stripe (15 of 18). American was led by Jesse Reed with 16 points, five rebounds, four assists and three steals.

CHARLES STEPS INTO STARTING LINEUP: Freshman forward **Karl Charles** has made an immediate impact for the Crusaders this season. In 26 games played, Charles has averaged 10.3 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.0 steals per contest, while hitting 78.0 percent of his free throws (92 of 118). He has stepped up his play even more since the start of Patriot League action, averaging 10.9 points and 5.1 rebounds against conference foes, and hitting 80.0 percent of his foul shots (60 of 75). During the victory over Lafayette, Charles recorded 10 points, six rebounds and two assists. Previously against Bucknell, he totaled 13 points, five rebounds and three assists. Charles also played well against Army, posting his first career double-double with 20 points and 15 rebounds. A few of his other top games have come against Colgate (career-high 21 points, eight rebounds, five assists, four blocked shots, three steals), against Loyola (17 points, eight rebounds), at Navy (16 points, five rebounds, three steals), against Sacred Heart (15 points, seven rebounds), against Boston University (15 points, six rebounds, five assists), at Hartford (13 points, three assists), against Maine (13 points) and at Kansas (12 points, four steals, three rebounds). Charles came to Holy Cross from Rutgers Preparatory School in Somerset, N.J., where he averaged 15.6 points, 8.2 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.6 steals per game as a senior.

CRUSADERS IN THE COMMUNITY: The Holy Cross men's basketball team has held a number of special events at its home games throughout the 2015-2016 season. During the Lafayette game on Feb. 10, the Crusaders partnered with the 15-40 Connection to hold its first-ever Orange Out event, to raise awareness for early cancer detection. At the Feb. 6 contest against Bucknell, Holy Cross held Diabetes Awareness Day in conjunction with the American Diabetes Association and Novo Nordisk. And during the Jan. 27 game against Loyola (Md.), members of the Holy Cross coaching staff took part in Coaches vs. Cancer Suits & Sneakers Awareness Week.

THOMPSON RETURNS TO BACKCOURT: Junior guard **Anthony Thompson** is once again a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt this year. In 25 games played, Thompson has averaged 7.1 points, 2.8 assists, 2.4 rebounds and 1.1 steals per contest, while hitting 76.8 percent of his free throws (53 of 69). During the victory over Lafayette, he totaled 12 points, three rebounds and two assists. Previously against Bucknell, Thompson scored 11 points. He also played well against Albany, totaling a career-high 23 points, four rebounds and three assists, while hitting six of 10 attempts from three-point range. A few of Thompson's other top games this season have come at Bucknell (16 points, three rebounds, three assists, two steals), at Colgate (14 points, three assists, two rebounds, two steals), against Harvard (13 points, seven of seven free throws), against Sacred Heart (10 points, three assists, two rebounds, two steals) and against New Hampshire (11 points, five assists, four steals). In 20 games played last season, he averaged 5.9 points, 2.2 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.3 steals. In 2013-2014, Thompson was named to the Patriot League All-Rookie team after averaging 9.4 points, 2.5 assists, 2.2 rebounds and 0.9 steals per game. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, he has now totaled 604 points, 193 assists, 175 rebounds and 85 steals, while making 74.3 percent of his free throws (194 of 261).

CRUSADERS AT THE HART CENTER: Holy Cross currently owns an all-time record of 363-151 at the Hart Center, including an 8-5 mark so far this season. The Crusaders posted their 300th win in the building against Sacred Heart on Nov. 14, 2008. Holy Cross had a 23-game winning streak at the Hart Center from Feb. 15, 2006-Jan. 2, 2008, which was the longest streak in the history of the building and the sixth-longest home court winning streak in the nation at the time. In 2006-2007 the Crusaders posted a perfect 14-0 mark at the Hart Center, setting a school record for the most home victories since they moved into the building. During the Hart Center's history, Holy Cross has posted a winning record at home in 34 out of 40 seasons, while recording double-figure home victories 18 times. The Crusaders stand 151-59 at home since the beginning of the 2000-2001 season, including a 98-33 record against Patriot League foes.

GREEN PLAYS KEY ROLE ON THE PERIMETER: After missing the first 16 games of the season due to injury, senior guard **Eric Green** has been one of the top all-around players off the Crusader bench over the last few weeks. In 10 games played, Green has averaged 4.2 points and 2.2 rebounds, while hitting 47.4 percent of his field goal attempts (18 of 38). During the Bucknell game, he totaled a season-high 11 points and three rebounds. Green also had four points and five rebounds at American, while posting six points, five rebounds and two steals in the win over Navy. In 30 games played last year, he averaged 6.5 points, 3.2 rebounds and 1.4 steals per contest. Over the course of his Holy Cross career, Green has now totaled 507 points, 254 rebounds, 108 steals and 100 assists.

FOUR CRUSADERS NAMED TO PATRIOT LEAGUE 25TH ANNIVERSARY TEAM: Four former Holy Cross men's basketball players were selected to the Patriot League 25th Anniversary Team, comprised of the top 25 players in the history of the conference. **Rob Feaster** (1991-1995), **Kevin Hamilton** (2002-2006), **Keith Simmons** (2003-2007) and **Tim Szatko** (1999-2003) were all recognized for their outstanding accomplishments during their careers with the Crusaders. Holy Cross' four selections were the second-most in the league, behind only Bucknell with six.

TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE: This year marks the 97th season of Holy Cross men's basketball. The Crusaders own an overall record of 1370-948 (.591), while making 25 postseason tournament appearances — 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament, 12 to the National Invitation Tournament and one to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. In the history of collegiate basketball, Holy Cross is one of only 16 schools to have won the NCAA Tournament (1946-1947) as well as the National Invitational Tournament (1953-1954). Throughout its history, Holy Cross has had six first team All-America selections, sent 10 players to the National Basketball Association, had four players and coaches inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, had 23 players drafted by professional teams, had three players go on to coach professionally, and had 15 players who have coached in college.

CRUSADERS KNOCK DOWN FREE THROWS: Holy Cross is once again a solid free throw shooting team in 2015-2016. Through 26 games played, the Crusaders have made 70.5 percent of their foul shots (356 of 505). Senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** leads the team by making 80.8 percent of his attempts at this charity stripe this season (42 of 52). Freshman forward **Karl Charles** (78.0 percent, 92 of 118), junior guard **Anthony Thompson** (76.8 percent, 53 of 69) and junior guard **Robert Champion** (73.7 percent, 56 of 76) have also connected on over 73 percent of their foul shots this year. As a team, the Crusaders have hit over 70 percent of their free throws in each of the last four seasons. Holy Cross made 71.5 percent of its foul shots in 2014-2015 (406 of 568), 73.2 percent in 2013-2014 (518 of 708), 75.3 percent in 2012-2013 (351 of 466) and 72.1 percent in 2011-2012 (374 of 519).

CRUSADERS HAVE TWO 20-POINT SCORERS AGAIN: During the Jan. 30 win over Navy, two Holy Cross players scored at least 20 points. Junior forward **Malachi Alexander** led the way with 26 points, while senior guard **Cullen Hamilton** finished with 24 points. That marked the third time this season that two Crusaders have hit the 20-point mark in the same game. During the Army game on Jan. 20, both Alexander and freshman forward **Karl Charles** scored 20 points, while in the Jan. 6 contest against Colgate, Charles scored 21 points and Hamilton added 20 points. Holy Cross has now won six straight games when it has multiple 20-point scorers, dating back to the 2011-2012 season.

ZIGNORSKI PLAYS KEY ROLE OFF THE BENCH: Freshman guard **Matt Zignorski** has become a key part of the Holy Cross backcourt rotation this year. In 23 games played, Zignorski has averaged 4.0 points per game while hitting 38.3 percent (18 of 47) of his three-point field goals. During the Rhode Island game, he scored 10 points and grabbed two rebounds. Previously against Sacred Heart, Zignorski totaled 13 points and two rebounds. He also played well at Quinnipiac, finishing with 10 points and two assists. Zignorski came to Holy Cross from Pope John XXIII Regional High School in Sparta, N.J., where he led the team to an overall record of 29-4 and the New Jersey Non-Public A state championship as a senior.

CARMODY IN FIRST SEASON WITH THE CRUSADERS: Bill Carmody is in his first season as the head men's basketball coach at Holy Cross in 2015-2016, with an overall record of 10-16. The 17th head coach in the history of the program, Carmody came to the Crusaders with 32 years of Division I coaching experience, including 17 seasons as a head coach. From 2000-2013, Carmody served as the head coach at Northwestern University. In the four years from 2008-2012, he guided the Wildcats to four consecutive winning seasons, with his 2009-2010 and 2010-2011 teams both recording a school record 20 victories. Carmody, who previously spent four seasons as the head coach at Princeton University from 1996-2000, had led his teams to eight postseason tournament appearances — two trips to the NCAA Tournament and six trips to the National Invitation Tournament. He was selected as the Big Ten Conference Coach of the Year in 2003-2004, and owns a career record of 294-261.

HUSEK STEPS UP IN THE POST: Junior center **Matt Husek** has developed into one of Holy Cross' top players down low this season. In 26 games played, Husek has averaged 6.3 points, 3.5 rebounds and 1.0 blocked shots per contest, while hitting 39.1 percent of his three-pointers (18 of 46). During the first Lehigh game, he led the team with a career-high 23 points on eight of 11 shooting from the field. Previously against Maine, Husek posted his second double-double of the year with 19 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. He also played well at Hartford, totaling 11 points and eight rebounds. A few of Husek's other top performances this season came against Quinnipiac (15 points, five rebounds, two assists, two blocks) and Marist (12 points, 12 rebounds). Last season, Husek averaged 3.0 points and 0.9 rebounds in 22 games played. Over the course of his collegiate career, he has now totaled 230 points, 116 rebounds and 42 blocked shots.

DRIBBLES: Freshman forward **Jehyve Floyd** scored a career-high seven points in the Jan. 20 victory over Army ... Freshman guard **Pat Benzan** posted career-highs of six assists and four rebounds against Lehigh on Jan. 16 ... During the Jan. 13 game at Lafayette, the Crusaders did not allow the Leopards to grab any offensive rebounds ... Junior guard **Robert Champion** scored at least 20 points three times in a four-game stretch from Dec. 12-Jan. 2. Prior to Champion, the last Crusader with three 20-point performances in a four-game stretch was Devin Brown, who accomplished the feat in three straight games from Jan. 3-11, 2012 ... The Crusaders stand 16-10 all-time in their first Patriot League game of the season, following this year's 80-64 victory over Boston University. Holy Cross has now won its opening Patriot League game 11 times in the last 17 years ... Holy Cross made a season-high 66.0 percent of its field goal attempts (33 of 50) in the 90-68 victory at Hartford on Dec. 12 ... The 50-49 victory over Harvard marked the first time the Crusaders won a game when scoring 50 points or less since Nov. 9, 2012 (a 46-45 win at Old Dominion) ... In the Nov. 19 game against New Hampshire, the Crusaders tied the school single-game records for both three-point field goals made (15) and three-point field goals attempted (35), in addition to tying the Hart Center record with 15 three-pointers made ... With the 67-64 victory at Marist, Holy Cross improved to 68-29 all-time in season openers. The Crusaders have now won two straight openers and three of their last four ... In the latest NCAA Graduation Success Rate Report, for the four-class aggregate of entering classes from 2005 through 2008, the Crusader men's basketball team posted a perfect 100 percent graduation rate. Holy Cross' overall Graduation Success Rate for all student-athletes was 98 percent, tied for the third-best mark among all Division I schools ... Holy Cross has received an NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award in each of the last 10 seasons, for having a multi-year APR in the top 10 percent of all Division I men's basketball teams in the nation.
